### **Committee Reports**

**Clubhouse & Pool.** Stephen noted that he was concerned about who is monitoring the cameras around the pool and clubhouse area. He talked to Rick Collins and Rick has agreed to continue to monitor these cameras.

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Additional pool keys ordered Pool will open on time for labor day weekend. Lock for the gate still needs to be put on the gate. Pool lights have been ordered.

**Lake, Buildings & Grounds.** Dave is looking into stocking the lake with additional fish. He will work with the Virginia Department of fishing/private-pond-management/fish-stocking

The Board will continue to research and evaluate what should be done to repair the entrance to the Club House

**Roads.** Dave brought up a problem on Sylvan Lane the drain ditch has been washing away due to all the rain. He has gotten an estimate of \$3,000 to fix the problem that will cover 2 locations on Sylvan Lane.

**Architecture.** Pat presented two applications for construction projects, which were approved by the Board unanimously. Jamieson and Valerie Miller lot 130 of 246 Powderhorn Lane is going to replace an existing shed same location a little larger, existing is 10'X14' the new one will be 10'X18'. They have a signed variance from their neighbor next door because the shed will be 40' feet from their shared property line. Gerry Monnat and Donna Phillips lot 69 of 811 Malvern Dr. are installing a fence behind the house next to the pool which is already fenced in. Both of the projects are in line with the covenants.

**Social Events.** Nothing to report.

**New Business.** Dave opened up for discussion the possibility of not having a board meeting every month, maybe quarterly or every other month. This topic was tabled.
